Our free clinical waste service is for the collection and disposal of healthcare waste and sharps that are hazardous or infectious as these should not be disposed of in your household rubbish bin.



A free kerbside collection of small electrical items and household batteries with your normal rubbish collection. Visit our household small electricals webpage for further information.



We offer assisted collection services for residents who are physically unable to take out their rubbish, recycling and garden waste to the boundary of their property.
