<p>Proxy Vote Application for a Specific Election or Referendum</p>	<p>This type of application is available to all electors.</p> <p>It will be valid for one election/referendum only.</p> <p>You must provide a reason as to why you are applying for a proxy vote.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Online</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Paper Application Form</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Yes</p>
<p>Proxy vote for a Definite or Indefinite Period as a journey by sea or air will be necessary to get to a polling station</p>	<p>This type of application is available to all electors. However, your reason for being unable to attend a polling station to vote must be due to the journey requiring sea or air travel.</p> <p>This could be, for example, because you are on holiday or away on business.</p> <p>Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity.</p> <p>No further evidence is required to support this type of application.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Online</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Yes</p>
<p>Proxy Vote Application for a Definite or Indefinite Period for <u>registered</u> Overseas Electors</p>	<p>This type of application is available to those registered as an overseas elector.</p> <p>Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity.</p> <p>No further evidence is required to support this type of application.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Online</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Paper Application Form (Overseas Electors)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Yes</p>

<p>Proxy Vote Application for a Definite or Indefinite Period for <u>registered</u> Services Electors who are in the Armed Forces or is the Spouse/Civil Partner of an individual in the Armed Forces.</p>	<p>This type of application is available to those who are in the Armed Forces (or a spouse/civil partner of an individual who is) and are registered as a service elector or service spouse.</p> <p>Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity.</p> <p>No further evidence is required to support this type of application.</p>	<p>Online</p> <p>Paper Application Form (Armed Forces Electors/Spouse or Civil Partners)</p>	<p>Yes</p>
<p>Proxy Vote Application for a Definite or Indefinite Period for <u>registered</u> Services Electors who are a Crown Servant or British Council employee or the Spouse/Civil Partner of an individual in either occupation.</p>	<p>This type of application is available to those who are a Crown Servant or British Council employee (or a spouse/civil partner of an individual who is) and are registered as a service elector or service spouse.</p> <p>Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity.</p> <p>No further evidence is required to support this type of application.</p>	<p>Online</p> <p>Paper Application Form (Crown Servant or British Council Employees/Spouse or Civil Partners)</p>	<p>Yes</p>

Proxy Vote for a Definite or Indefinite Period due to Disability	<p>This type of application is available for individuals who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cannot vote in person due to a disability. • Cannot vote in person as they have been detained in hospital under the civil sections of the Mental Health Act 1983. <p>This type of application requires further evidence to support the need for such arrangement.</p> <p>Evidence required is detailed in the application form or online process.</p> <p>Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity.</p>	<p>Online</p> <p>Paper Application Form</p>	<p>Yes</p>
Proxy Vote for a Definite or Indefinite Period due to Employment	<p>This type of application is available for individuals whose:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Employment or their spouse or civil partner's employment means that they cannot vote in person. <p>This type of application requires further evidence to support the need for such arrangement.</p> <p>Evidence required is detailed in the application form or online process.</p> <p>Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity.</p>	<p>Online</p> <p>Paper Application Form</p>	<p>Yes</p>

Proxy Vote for a Definite or Indefinite Period due to Education	<p>This type of application is available for individuals who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Will be attending an educational course which means they cannot vote in person, or; • Their spouse or civil partner will be attending an educational course, which means they cannot vote in person. <p>This type of application requires further evidence to support the need for such arrangement.</p> <p>Evidence required is detailed in the application form or online process.</p> <p>Applicants can apply for a definite or indefinite period of validity.</p>	<p>Online</p> <p>Paper Application Form</p>	<p>Yes</p>

Postal Proxy Application	<p>If your nominated proxy cannot get to your polling station on polling day, they can apply to vote by post as a postal proxy.</p> <p>They will follow the same application process as a regular postal voter, however – this type of application can only be completed via a paper application form.</p>	Paper Application Form <i>(Please contact the Electoral Services Team to request an application form)</i>	Yes
