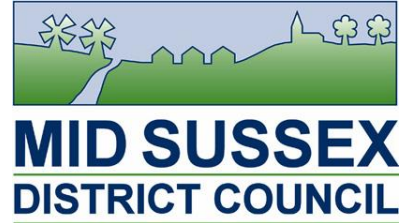


Hurstpierpoint Conservation Areas Appraisal



Consultation Response Form

As part of a programme of reviewing and expanding Conservation Area Appraisals across the District, Mid Sussex District Council, in collaboration with the Hurstpierpoint Society, has prepared a draft Conservation Areas Appraisal for the Hurstpierpoint, Langton Lane and Hurst Wickham Conservation Areas.

The Draft Hurstpierpoint Conservation Areas Appraisal identifies the qualities which contribute to the special character of each of the three areas, as well as considering how these qualities can be preserved and enhanced through management of change. The Draft Appraisal also includes a review of the boundaries to each of the three conservation areas and as a result alterations are proposed to the boundaries of Hurstpierpoint and Hurst Wickham Conservation Areas.

Mid Sussex District Council would like to hear your views on the Draft Hurstpierpoint Conservation Areas Appraisal and on the proposed changes to the boundaries of Hurstpierpoint and Hurst Wickham Conservation Areas. The responses from the consultation will be taken into account in the production of the final Appraisal document.

The Hurstpierpoint Conservation Areas Appraisal will be the subject of a six-week period of formal public consultation from Monday 16th April until Tuesday 29th May 2018. Representations on these documents should be received by midnight on Tuesday 29th May 2018.
