# Hearing Statement by John Spencer Councillor of Albourne Parish Council.

With regards to DPC3 – 7 Albourne Parish Council confirm that they reject the proposal in the District Plan. There are questions that we have asked why these sites have come forward in our Reg 19 response submitted in February 2024 which will be asked as part of your examination.

Should these site progress they represent the development of a new small town, with a stated intention to plan these as a single entity as expressed in the draft Local Plan page 170 (and as encouraged by MSDC's consultant). This surely needs Community Engagement? We have on a few occasions stated that both Albourne PC and the residents of Albourne wish to be involved in community consultation. MSDC are stating that they have engaged in community consultation, we confirm there has been NO consultation by MSDC we have only been informed of their plans.

The meetings we have had with MSDC have only been to provide information of what MSDC are proposing. They have listened to some of our concerns but have only responded by saying they will be mitigated in the detail design.

Many of our concerns are given in our Representation and if these are addressed then this will be a step forward into community engagement but what we would like is to work together with MSDC on this sites.
