### Description of premises

#### Description

It is a rented storage shipping container, which resides on a rural location, kept amongst a row of containers. There are no residential properties nearby. It is a secure metal shipping container with a metal door, and padlock. The padlock is protected from attempted theft or interference by a strong metal cover.

At the entrance to the site there is a secure locked gate which is closed 24/7 and only accessible with the use of an access card which is only held by container leaseholders for security.

There is already a 24/7 recorded surveillance camera system which covers the gate and storage containers, the camera at the gate also has ANPR cameras which will flag up any attempted access to the site by any unrecognised vehicles.

We will also be putting in place our own camera system on the container if required, which we will have 24 hour remote access to view on our phones.

It is being used for the sole purpose of storage of alcohol, beverages and packaged snacks, for delivery distribution.

No-one other than the two named premises license holders; Genardo Campbell and Alice Collick will have access to or be attending the container.

No Alcohol will be sold on the premises and no customers will be allowed to visit the site.

## Licensing Objectives

By facilitating the sale of alcohol via delivery at a customers own home, preventing drunk and disorderly behaviour in public spaces and

prevents the general public from being inclined to drink and drive - therefore reducing harm to the public and reducing pressure on emergency and public services.  
No alcohol will be sold to persons that are already heavily intoxicated or at risk of harm.  
As we are visiting the location in which the alcohol is being or has been consumed, we will be in the perfect position to perform welfare type checks and contact the relevant authorities to alert and or prevent harm/misconduct/crime and disorder.  
All alcohol sales will be strictly subject to challenge 25 identification and sales will be refused immediately and customer flagged on our system if this not complied with.

**The prevention of crime and disorder:**

The site in which the container is on has a 24/7 locked gate which requires an access card which only ourselves and other container leaseholders have in their possession. There is a ANPR camera system in place on arrival at the site gate, which flags any unrecognised vehicles attempting to access the property.  
the container has a metal door with a padlock which has a metal cover to prevent interference or forced entry.  
we can if required also set up our own camera surveillance on the container connected to our phones to allow remote 24/7 access to ensure the property is secure from offenders.  
No items will be visible or on display, and the storage location will not be made known to the general public.  
The property will be regularly maintained.  
We will be working in close conjunction with Sussex police, Fire and Ambulance services.  
We will be reporting any anti-social behaviour or road user concerns whilst we are out driving or delivering to local authorities- therefore ensuring safer roads and more eyes on community watch.

**Public safety:**

All alcohol will be sold responsibly with verified identification.  
The storage container will be kept in an organised manner with pathways kept clear to prevents fires and hazards.  
If required, we will install fire and carbon monoxide alarms.  
We will have all appropriate business and premises insurances.  
The premises will comply with all required fire and safety regulations.  
We will as extra safety and assistance, complete a first aid at work course.  
We will promote the prevention of binge drinking and also all alcohol sales do not fall below the cost of duty + VAT.

**The prevention of public nuisance:**

Access to the storage container will be kept to a minimum and at a reasonable hour, this will all be done respectfully and quietly.  
Due to the remote location of our storage container, it is incredibly unlikely to impact residents or cause public nuisance as there are no residential properties nearby and no shops or public spaces either.  
As we are facilitating the consumption of alcohol within a persons own home/business, we are hoping this will drastically reduce the level of public nuisance occurring currently with people travelling to and from late night shops/bars.  
We will also be an extra set of eyes on the road late at night, to support the emergency services and protect the general public.  
we will dispose of all of our packaging waste according to COSHH guidelines in a proper and effective manner to guarantee good waste



management; this will all be disposed of at a sociable hour to keep noise pollution to a minimum.

**The protection of children from harm:**

We will operate a strict challenge 25 policy, with only authorised and signed identification; passport/driving license or military I.D.  
We will deliver all alcohol personally.  
All of our advertising material will clearly state CHALLENGE 25.  
We will also operate a instant refusal policy, and a refusal log; any concerning incidents or situations attended will be logged and reported to the relevant authorities.  
If and when we get to a scale in which we require employees, we will be enforcing staff training, which details all of the above. when we are confident this has been learnt we will be authorising and requesting staff signatures to prove their completion of training, compliance and understanding.  
Even when employees are in place it will only be us as premises licence holders that will ever attend or have access to the unit.  
No other persons/customers will ever be attending the premises or unit.
