

The protection of children from harm	There will be a Challenge 25 policy operating at the premises. Challenge 25 means that the holder of the premises licence shall ensure that every individual, who visually appears to be under 25 years of age and is seeking to purchase or be supplied with alcohol at the premises or from the premises, shall produce identification proving that individual to be 18 years of age or older. Acceptable identification for the purposes of age verification will include a driving licence, passport or photographic identification bearing the "PASS" logo and the person's date of birth. If the person seeking alcohol is unable to produce acceptable means of identfication, no sale or supply of alcohol will be made to or for that person. • In the event that an employee suspects that a person	

attempting to purchase alcohol is under the age of 25, is a street drinker or is attempting a proxy purchase they will immediately call the duty manager. The duty manager will make appropriate enquiries and will determine whether the sale should be permitted. • Challenge 25' posters shall be displayed in prominent positions at the premises. • An automated till prompt will be set up so that the operator has to positively confirm that Challenge 25 has been complied with when the first item of alcohol has been scanned.
